Your Tile Mate will be dispatched after the 14 days of the cooling off period and within 21 days of the policy start date. No Tile Mate will be issued if the relevant customer cancels their policy within the cooling off period.

The terms and conditions of the manufacturer of the Tile Mate will apply including the warranties therein. It is the customer's responsibility to read the user manual provided with the Tile Mate. This offer is available to new customers only who purchase their policy through the masterquote.co.uk website. This offer is not available to customers amending or renewing their existing MasterQuote insurance policy. The customer named as the policyholder will receive the Tile.

Only one Tile Mate may be redeemed per eligible policy holder, regardless of whether a policy is taken out singly or jointly. The offer of the free Tile Mate is subject to availability.
